Highland Rim Cycling Classic Omnium Race (Road Race, Time Trial, Criterium)

- All 2011 USAC rules are in effect.
- Valid and current USAC license must be presented at registration.
- Racers may register for more than one category in the Criterium only.
- Points earned in different categories may not be combined.
- Promoter reserves the right to adjust start times, cancel/combine events and modify prize lists as necessary.
- Field sizes will be limited as specified in USAC Rules 1G6 & 1G7
- All Masters races are for Categories 1/4 only. Cat. 5 Masters may race with the Cat. 5's.
- Events will be held rain or shine.
- Helmets must be worn on the bike at all times. (USAC Rules 1K1)
- All numbers supplied by the promoter must be used. **NO FOLDING OR CUTTING OF NUMBERS IS ALLOWED.** They should be placed vertically on the right rib cage, numbers reading lower to higher, and horizontally on the lower back, numbers reading left to right. See positioning on display manikin at registration area. You will use the same number for all three races . . . Don't lose it! Replacements cost \$1 each.
- After completing your races, please do not congregate at the finish line.
- All races will have officials on the race courses, in the caravans and at the finish lines. Motor officials will support the road race.
- State, county and city law enforcement will provide support on all races.
- ALL payouts will be made on Sunday at the Farmers' Market Pavilion 30 MINUTES AFTER RACE RESULTS ARE IN. **In order to claim your prize money, you must present the paymaster with your USAC license or your hip number. To pick up prize money for a team mate or friend, you must also present the paymaster with his/her USCF license or hip number.** If you are unable to stay to pick up your prize money, it will be mailed to you provided we have a legible name and address on file. A \$3 fee will be deducted from the amount of the prize for postage and handling.

Road Race

- Packet Pick-Up will be near the Start/Finish line at Victory Free Will Baptist Church from 6 am to 30 minutes prior to your race time. *The centerline line rule will be strictly enforced for all USAC categories.*
(USAC 3B1)
- There will be corner marshals at all intersections on the courses. *Ultimately, it is the riders' responsibility to know each course!*
- Wheel vehicles will be provided for each category except Jr. 10-14. Wheels in, wheels out. **Wheels must be placed in wheel vehicle no later than 15 minutes**

prior to your race time. Wheels will not be accepted after that time. Wheels can be picked up at the finish area after the race. The Highland Rim Cycling Classic is not responsible for wheels and equipment left at the drop off area 30 minutes after they are deposited.

- All feed zones will have neutral water and bananas. There will be two feed zones on the 55-mile loop, but the first zone (on Hwy. 8) will be a Pro 1,2 *only* zone. The second zone (on Hwy. 111) will support all categories. Feed zones will be clearly marked.
- Staging area and Start/Finish line will be 3 miles southeast of McMinnville on Hwy. 8. *Each category will be pre-staged on Old Harrison Ferry Rd. behind Victory Free Will Baptist Church.*
- Parking will be available on both shoulders of Hwy. 8 and in the parking lot of Victory Free Will Baptist Church.
- The Pro 1,2 group will complete 2 laps of the Main Loop (see Road Race map). Jrs. 10-14 will do laps on the 4.5 mile loop at the Start/Finish area. All others will do 1 lap of the Main Loop.

Time Trial

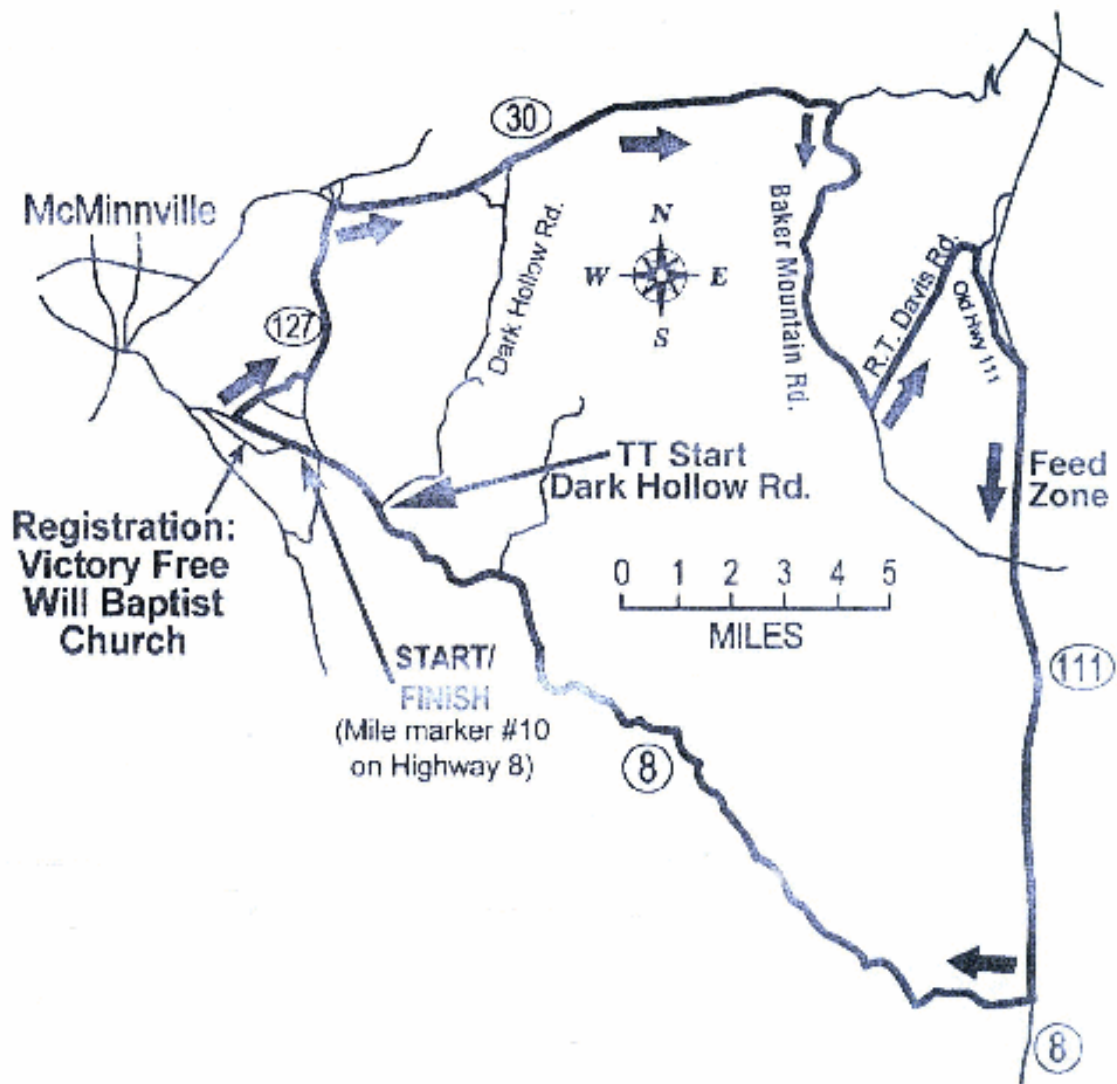
- The Time Trial will be a 2.5 mile hill climb located on Hwy. 8, SE of the Collins River. The start point will begin at Dark Hollow Road.
- The grade is 8%.
- Start times will be posted at the registration area at Victory Free Will Baptist Church by about 12 Noon.
- The first rider starts at 3:31 pm, and the rest will follow at 30 second intervals.
- No warming-up on the course.
- Please heed parking signs and instructions. Violators will be towed.

Criterion

- Pre-registered riders must pick up packets 30 minutes before start time of their race. Registration area is at the Student Entrance of Warren County High School.
- Start/Finish area is by the Student/ Gymnasium entrance of the school. Please refer to course map for more detailed information.
- Parking is available inside the course (grassy auxiliary field, side and back-parking area)
